

School Uniform at Priorswood Primary School

At Priorswood Primary School uniform is compulsory for all children.

Our aim is to have a uniform that supports all of our pupils to develop the highest standards of personal presentation which we know will stand them in good stead as successful young adults. The uniform remains smart and also practical; by wearing it, children show that they are part of the school, take pride in representing the school and the uniform provides children with a collective identity.

All uniform items need to be clearly named.



School Uniform

For your information, listed below is the required school uniform for Priorswood Primary School:

- Bottle Green v-neck sweatshirt or cardigan **with school logo**
- Plain white polo shirt (tucked in)
- Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- Black sensible school shoes - shoes must be "polishable" - no boots, trainers or canvas shoes
- Grey, white or black socks / grey or black tights
- Green and white gingham dress in the warm weather
- Bottle Green logo book bag (optional but incredibly helpful!)

Jewellery, PE Kit and Hairstyles

Children should not wear any jewellery other than one silver or gold stud earring per ear and a watch. Long hair should be tied back at all times.

Every child is expected to wear the correct PE kit in every lesson. This kit consists of a **green logo t-shirt**, black shorts and trainers or black daps. In winter children may add jogging bottoms and a sweatshirt.

Hair should be of one natural colour and no shorter than a number 3: buzz cuts, tram lines or extreme styles and colours are not allowed.

Pupils are not permitted to wear nail varnish or transfer tattoos in school.
